Covid-19 Relief Funds: The City's Coronavirus Relief Fund Grant Application was receipted in on December 28, 2020. If the grant application is approved the City will receive \$50,000.00 in Corona Relief Funding. The City was not told when we would hear back about the allocation of funds.

City Hall Hours: As of Monday, January 11, 2021, City Hall entrance will reopen to the general public and staff will resume regular work hours of Monday – Thursday's 7:30 – 5:00 p.m. and Fridays, 7:30 – 12:00 noon. The Library will remain closed to the public with Curb-side services only. Due to the winter weather causing, at times, extreme conditions to those who use the walk up window, I feel it's best to allow people to enter into City Hall. All persons entering City Hall will have to stay outside of the administrative office space, they will be offered the use of hand sanitizers, with social distancing and face masks required. Citizens will still have the ability to conduct business with city staff via, phone, email, on-line payments, drop box correspondence, U.S. mail and personal meeting by appointment only.

Street Sweeping: I have not forgotten about placing the official name on the street sweeper. As soon as we get some warmer/dryer weather we will place the name strips on the sweeper.
