American Rescue Plan Act of 2021: The City received it's first, of two, ARPA Appropriations in the amount of \$111,217.01. The other half of the \$222,434.02 appropriations will be sent out on or before October 1, 2022. City staff will be meeting to discuss city needs, along with City Engineer, Ryan Quigley and will present ideas to council at the October 11, 2021 city council meeting.

Rapid Response/Safe Routes to School Grant: The City has been notified that we will be receiving the \$500,000.00 Rapid Response Grant. This grant along with the Scio School Districts \$125K grant match and the City's \$25K contribution will total \$650,000.00 towards safety improvements on NW 1st Avenue. The Intergovernmental Agreement is currently being reviewed by the Oregon Justice Department before being sent to the City of Scio for review and signature.

Sewer Lagoons: The sewer lagoons are back to normal since the anaerobic bloom that occurred in August. Staff will be meeting with the City Engineer to discuss the lagoons and will be reporting back to council on this issue at the October 11, 2021 meeting.
