Flags on Main Street and Flags on Poles: I had a meeting with Josh Edwards, Scio District Supervisor, for the Linn County Road Department. We discussed the following items:

- Intersection at Hwy 226 and Richardson Gap
- Scio/Jefferson Road on corner of NW 4th – bent reflectors
- Flag pole holders on Main Street
- S.W. 6th Street
- Culvert on S.W. 6th Street

Meeting with Downtown Business Leaders and Fire Chief: I reached out to Katrina Clouse to schedule a meeting with her, Mike Scofield and Levi Echardt to discuss the flags on the city poles and along main street. We will work together to come up with solutions to the ongoing flag concerns throughout town.

Rapid Response/Safe Routes to School Grant: Assistant City Attorney, Jeffrey Clayson completed his review of the Rapid Response Grant Intergovernmental Agreement and has given permission to the city to proceed with the grant with special attention being given to the time line for the completion of the project. Thus, city staff, City Engineer Ryan Quigley, and Scio School Superintendent Steve Martinelli will be meeting to go over the project deadlines on Wednesday, October 13, 2021.

Sewer Lagoons: City Public Works crew will be meeting with Pat Hare, City Administrator for Adair Village and his Public Works Superintendent to discuss our sewer lagoons and their operation. Pat and his crew specialize in lagoon operations and believes that he can help us in eliminating anerobic flips. A meeting is scheduled to take place in Mid-October.
